### **OBJECTIVE**

Celebrate the beauty and resilience of hydropower in winter. Show how hydropower facilities thrive in harmony with the serene, snow-covered, or icy landscapes, symbolizing energy and sustainability throughout the year.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

The competition is open to all professional and amateur photographers with an interest in hydropower. Examples of topics:

- Snow and Ice Around Hydropower Plants
- Seasonal Reflections in Water
- Hydropower in Winter Landscapes
- Lights and Energy: End-of-Year Magic
- Wildlife and Hydropower in Winter

#### **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

- Format: Digital photos in JPEG or PNG format.
- **Resolution**: Minimum 300 dpi. Photos should be at least 3,000 pixels on the shortest side.
- File Size: Each photo should be no larger than 10 MB.
- **Naming Convention**: Files should be named in the format: LastName\_FirstName\_\_Title.jpg (e.g., Doe\_John\_\_RiverPower.jpg).

## **ENTRY DEADLINE**

All entries must be received by 18 December 2024 no later than 11:59 PM CET

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

- Relevance to Winter Theme (30%)
- Artistic Composition (25%)
- Seasonal Atmosphere (20%)
- Originality and Impact (25%)

#### **NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS**

Winners will be notified by 20 December and announced publicly on the same day. Winning photos will be featured in our end-of-the-year greeting materials and on our website.
